INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES

The start of examinations

Examinations start at 9:00 (morning session) and at 13:00 (afternoon session). Students must arrive at the school one hour before the start of the examination starts, which means that students must arrive at the school at 8:00 for morning session and at 12:00 for afternoon session. Students have to **arrive at the examination room half an hour before the start of the examination. The time for the resetting calculators is given in the schedule.** It is the responsibility of each student to be on time to reset the calculator otherwise the calculator will not be permitted for the use in the exam.

Each student is responsible for timely arrival at the examination room. Students who are late, will not be permitted to the examination room. There is a 30 minute break between Biology/Chemistry/Physics Papers 1 and 2 examination. During the break, all students are advised to stay in the school premises.

Students are not allowed to leave the examination room during the first 60 minutes of the examination, and 15 minutes before the end of the examination. If the examination is shorter than 60 minutes, students are not allowed to leave the examination room.

Items not permitted

- Correction fluid/pens
- Rough/scratch paper
- A bilingual translation dictionary for studies in literature and language acquisition exams
- Notes, books, guides, or reference material of any kind
- Wearable technology (smart watches, smartphones, smart glasses)
- Electronic equipment (personal computer, laptop)
- Refreshments

During examination

- Students check their identity against answer coversheets/multiple-choice answer sheets. Retake candidates must produce proof of their identity.
- It is preferable that the students do not take to their desk or table any form of container in which to hold their stationery.
- Students may take to their desks or tables only the following items:
 - ✓ General stationery (pens, pencils, an eraser, a ruler, geometry instruments)
 - ✓ A bilingual translation dictionary for groups 3,4,5 and 6
 - ✓ Other materials specified by IB for a particular examination (a calculator, formula booklet)
 - ✓ A pencil with a soft lead that produces dark lines for MCQ sheets
- Students must write their answers in dark blue or black ink
- Students are advised to use eligible handwriting. If an examiner cannot read a script, then they cannot mark it.
- Students are allowed 5 minutes of reading time at a start of every examination (except for multiple-choice examination papers). These 5 minutes do not count as part of the time allowed for the examination, which is stated on the front cover of the examination paper. These 5 minutes are devoted to reading only, not using calculators or any other activity.
- Students must not share stationery, dictionaries, calculators or any other materials during the examinations

Ending examination

- Each student's responsible is to correctly complete coversheets for the examination. Students must attach materials using a string tag in the following sequence: coversheet at the front, followed by the structured examination paper, then answer booklet(s) and finally any graph paper that has been used
- Students must place their examination material on their desks or tables so that it can be easily collected from them
- Students must not take with them any examination paper, data booklets, answer booklets or graph paper out of the examination room.

Misconduct

Any act of misconduct by a student in relation to the examinations must be reported to the IB Assessment Centre. Academic misconduct constitutes a breach of regulations that, if confirmed by the final award committee, will result in no grade being awarded in the subject and level concerned.

The following are examples of misconduct in relation to written examinations:

- Possession of unauthorized material
- Failing to obey the DP Coordinator's or an invigilator's instructions
- Communicating with another student
- Behaving in such a way that it may disrupt the examination or disturb other students
- Stealing examination papers or removing examination material (answer booklets, examination papers) from the examination room
- Continuing to answer examination papers after the examination is over
- Leaving the examination room without permission
- Discussing the content of any examination paper with any person outside the school community within 24 hours after the examination
